Hard Not easily broken or bent.

Waterproof If something is waterproof, it keeps water out. It keeps things dry.

Absorbent If something is absorbent, it soaks liquid up.

Transparent Transparent objects can be seen through.

Opaque Opaque objects can't be seen through.
